

Flexible Membership

This membership is directed at golfers who do not play sufficient golf to get value for money from a full membership.

The Flexible Membership is **£450.00** per annum plus EGU fees and insurance. An explanation and details of the membership are given below.

- Full membership of the club
- Full voting rights
- Handicap certificate
- Full entitlement to play in all club competitions at home and away
- A flexible member will receive 42 vouchers
 - 1 weekday round = 2 vouchers
 - 1 weekend round = 3 vouchers
- Extra vouchers can be purchased at £100.00 for 8 vouchers
- Unused vouchers may be carried over upon annual renewal. Resignation or dismissal from the club will result in the forfeit of unused vouchers
- Flexible membership vouchers are not transferable to another golfer and cannot be used as a green fee
- Flexible membership is restricted to the first 25 members; membership will be effective on full payment of fees
- Members must have one full year break in membership to re-join on the Flexible Membership (after the first 25 members).
- There is no restriction for new members taking up the Flexible Membership
- Flexible members will be able to transfer to the traditional Full Membership giving unlimited golf, if and when they require (full membership fee divided by 12 months) by paying the remaining portion of the full fee plus a £100 transfer fee
- Flexible members must report to the professional **prior to play** to confirm vouchers are correctly deducted from their voucher account. Failure to do so will lead to disciplinary action which may include the forfeit of any outstanding vouchers. Renewal of membership would not be considered
- In the event of the pro shop or office being closed you **must** place your vouchers in the box used for score cards, outside the office. This is irrespective of whether you tee off the first or another hole on the course.
- Flexible members will be required to acquaint themselves with and conform to the club rules and bye laws
- The membership committee may review the allocation of vouchers and make reasonable changes to the rules of membership when appropriate
