Visitors guide to 'Golf Safe Practise' here at Seacroft

As we start to play golf again in this current situation, we must be aware of various rules and policies of safe practise which we have not had to use before. Some of these policies have now become part of our daily life but some are quite new to the club so we aim to set them out here:-

Before Play

- All tee times **MUST** be booked in advance online or by telephone
- Tees are bookable online 6 days in advance. For bookings later on in the year please call the Pro Shop on 01754 763020 Ext 2.
- **DO NOT** turn up to play without a booked tee time
- Play is in one, two, three or four balls
After play you will not be able to leave your trolley or clubs but must take them home
- All visitors to the club are to park in the club car park rather than on the road
- Shoes must be changed at your car
- Entrance and exit with golf clubs is on **DRUMMOND ROAD ONLY**
- The clubhouse, locker rooms are **CLOSED**
- Clubhouse toilet facilities are open
- Golfers must not arrive more than 15 minutes before their booked tee time
- Both practise grounds are open
- The practise putting green is open but only 3 players are allowed on it at any one time and it can only be used prior to play
- Congregating before or after play is not allowed
- Trolleys and buggies can be hired and will be sanitised after each use, however, buggies are for sole use only unless shared by members of the same household

Around the Clubhouse

- Hand sanitiser is available by the putting green, outside the pro shop and by the clubhouse toilet facilities
- The pro shop is open for administrative purposes and as an information hub only
- Only two people apart from staff are allowed in the pro shop at any one time

On the Course

We hope you will enjoy your game of golf but please can we remind you that you must keep socially distanced (2 metres) from your playing partner at all times.

- As previously, the holes have an inset around the flagstick to prevent the ball falling to the base of the cup, the flagstick **MUST NOT** be touched
- Rakes have been removed from all bunkers. Please smooth sand with your feet or the back of your club and note the local rule re bunkers
- The on course toilets are open. Please sanitise your hands before and after using the facilities

It is absolutely vital that if you feel unwell you must stay away from the club.
